2025 Revol™ Rules

International Roundnet Federation Rules ([IRF Rules](#)) except for the following:

Equipment

Revol set and Revol Pro ball.

Ball inflation : The air pressure of the ball should be between 0,125 kg/cm² and 0,155 kg/cm² (1.8 and 2.2 PSI).

No ball pressure gauge? Bottom of the ball dropped from 2 m (6'7") must bounce 87 cm (34") high on a hard surface.

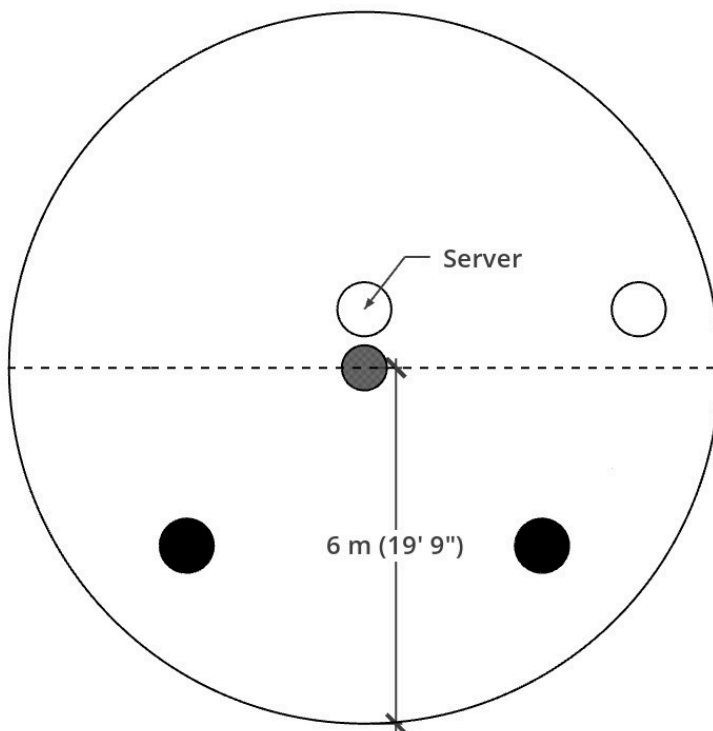
Out-of-bounds

Elite : Open 9,15 m (30') | Women & Beach : 8 m (26'3")

Advanced : Open 8 m (26'3") | Women & Beach : 7 m (23')

Intermediate : Open 7 m (23') | Women & Beach : 6 m (19'9")

Rookie : no out-of-bounds



Serve

Players serve two serves each, alternating in between teams.

If a game ties at 20-20, players serve one serve each.

After every 8 points, players switch sides to equalize conditions.

Characteristics of the serve :

One serve only.

Serving line splits the court in half.

Server stands in one half of the court and serves toward the other half.

Before the serve, the server's teammate can start anywhere they want in their half of the court.

The point starts when the server says the score, the receivers agree and the server says "service".

The server may only step after tossing the ball.

Both players can serve receive.

Serve fault if:

- a. The ball misses the target or hits the lip.
- b. The ball doesn't go higher than 2 m (6' 7") AND is not touched by a receiver.
- c. The ball lands out-of-bounds or in the wrong half of the court.
- d. The server makes contact on the other half of the court before demonstrating the momentum from the action has stopped and reestablishing bodily control.

Fault

Fault if:

- a. The ball touches the lip at any time during the point.
- b. The ball touches the ground out-of-bounds.

Carries

Carries are legal but the ball cannot be caught and/or thrown.
