Refer to the Service Manual for the torque values of the removed parts.


INSTALLATION

• To prevent burns, allow the engine, exhaust system, radiator, etc., to cool before installing the accessory.

NOTE:


- Disconnect the negative (-) cable from the battery before installing this accessory.
- The memories of the clock will be erased when you disconnect the battery. Reset the memories after reconnecting the battery.
- · Reinstall the removed parts on the motorcycle and make sure that the wires and harnesses are not pinched.
- Trim the excess ends off the wire ties after attaching them to the wire harnesses. Do not allow the cut part of the wire tie to interfere with another harness or brake hose.
- Although the illustration is of GL1800/D/DA, use the same procedures for other models.




5. Remove the right and left rear top lid as shown.Perform this step on GL1800B/BD only.



7. Remove the center rear top cover as shown.Perform this step on GL1800B/BD only.




- 11. Remove the battery band and battery as shown.
 - Disconnect the positive (+) cable of the battery.




- 12. Open the rear trunk lid as shown.

 - Refer to the Owner's Manual and using an emergency trunk cable to open the rear trunk lid.




- 13. Remove the USB code as shown.
 - Perform this step on GL1800DA only.




- 14. Remove the parts as shown.

15. Remove the front trunk lower panel as shown.Perform this step on GL1800/D/DA only.



 - Repeat on the left side.




RIGHT TRUNK SIDE COVER












