



CHECKLIST GRAFFITI REMOVAL BY HAND

1. Protective Equipment

- Gloves
- Safety goggles
- Full-cover clothing
- Respiratory protection if needed

2. Graffiti Remover

- Ensure you have the correct type of graffiti remover for the specific surface (e.g., wood, metal, concrete) to avoid causing damage to the surface.

3. Application Tools

- Brush, sponge, roller, or spray nozzle for applying.
- Cloth for removing the graffiti after.

4. Cloth and Water

- For wiping and cleaning the surface after the graffiti has been removed.

5. Cleaning Method

- We recommend testing a small area when working with a new type of surface or graffiti remover.
- Apply the graffiti remover according to the instructions.
- Allow the product to work for the recommended time.
- Use a cloth to remove the dissolved graffiti.
- Repeat if necessary.

6. Post-Treatment

- Clean with water and thoroughly wipe the surface.
- Optionally, apply a graffiti protection coating to prevent future graffiti damage.
