

1. Protective Equipment

- O Gloves
- O Safety goggles
- O Full-cover clothing
- O Respiratory protection if needed

2. Graffiti Remover

O Ensure you have the correct type of graffiti remover for the specific surface (e.g., wood, metal, concrete) to avoid causing damage to the surface.

3. Application Tools

- O Brush, sponge, roller, or spray nozzle for applying.
- O Cloth for removing the graffiti after.

4. Cloth and Water

O For wiping and cleaning the surface after the graffiti has been removed.

5. Cleaning Method

- **O** We recommend testing a small area when working with a new type of surface or graffiti remover.
- O Apply the graffiti remover according to the instructions.
- O Allow the product to work for the recommended time.
- O Use a cloth to remove the dissolved graffiti.
- O Repeat if necessary.

6. Post-Treatment

- O Clean with water and thoroughly wipe the surface.
- O Optionally, apply a graffiti protection coating to prevent future graffiti damage.
