

1. Safety Equipment

- O Nitrile or butyl rubber chemical gloves
- O Safety goggles or face shield
- O Full-cover clothing
- O Hearing protection if needed

2. High-Pressure Equipment

O With adjustable pressure and temperature suitable for the surface and graffiti.

3. Graffiti Remover

- O Choose the correct remover that is compatible with the surface and graffiti type.
- O We recommend testing a small area when working with a new type of surface or graffiti remover.

4. Area Preparation

- O Protect surrounding areas (e.g., windows and plants).
- O Cordone off the area if cleaning is to be carried out in a public space.

5. Application

- O Apply the chosen remover with a brush or roller.
- O Allow it to work according to the instructions.
- O Check if manual processing is needed.
- O Wash away the dissolved graffiti with appropriate pressure and temperature.

6. Post-Treatment

- O Inspect the surface to ensure all graffiti has been removed.
- O Check for any remaining shadows of graffiti. If so, find a suitable shadow remover and follow its instructions.
- O Apply graffiti protection if appropriate to prevent future graffiti damage.
