Thin graffiti remover

Area of use:

Thin-floating graffiti remover for sensitive surfaces such as plexiglass and road signs etc.

How to use:

Apply with a brush or cloth and agitate the surface.

Wipe the dissolved graffiti with a dry, clean cloth.

On painted surfaces, rinse or dry with a cloth and water.

Storage: Frost-free in original packing
